Innomotics Wins Zlatý Amper Award for Sustainable Motor Solution

Brno / Nuremberg, March 25, 2026 – Innomotics has received the prestigious Zlatý Amper (Golden Amper) Award in the “Best Sustainability Solution” category at the International Trade Fair for Electrical Engineering, Electronics and Energy AMPER in Brno. The award recognizes the company’s low-voltage IE5 and IE6 permanent magnet motors.

The Zlatý Amper in this category is one of the fair’s five main awards and is presented by an expert jury made up of electrical engineering specialists and university rectors. Products are evaluated based on innovation, technological contribution, and their impact on energy efficiency and sustainability. Innomotics was selected for the award in recognition of significant material savings in manufacturing, reduced motor size while maintaining the same power output, and substantial energy savings over the motors’ entire lifecycle.

At its exhibition booth, Innomotics showcased two motor units: a motor from the Frenštát facility with a frame size of 280 mm and 160 kW, and a motor from the Mohelnice facility with a frame size of 90 mm and 4 kW. The motors attracted strong interest and positive feedback from industry professionals and trade visitors, particularly due to their compact design and advances in efficiency and sustainability.

During the trade fair, the Czech Deputy Prime Minister and the Minister of Industry, just like the Minister of the Environment also visited the Innomotics booth. The discussions focused on sustainable technological trends and on how modern energy-efficient drive systems can contribute to increasing the energy efficiency of Czech industrial infrastructure.
